## A Commitment to the Game

Often as parents, we are confronted by the decision to choose between REC or Travel Baseball. We hope this sheds light on some of the detailed differences between the two programs.

- 1. It is a commitment...because of the **Time Involved**. Players must travel to and from surrounding NE OH cities any day of the week. Players start practicing as a team as early as November. The season starts mid-April and continues through the end of July. Players are expected to make all games during the season (April July). Arriving for a game can be as much as 1.0 hours prior to game time. All rain outs will be made up, setting up the possibility of several (3 or more games) in a week. All are meaningful differences that add up to a substantial time commitment.
- 2. It is a commitment...because of **Cost**. Travel baseball is significantly more expensive than REC baseball. Your participation in additional fundraising activity may also be required by all involved. Once players and parents have made this commitment, NO REFUNDS will be granted due to lack of commitment or injury.
- 3. It is a commitment.... because of **Playing Time**. Regular baseball rules apply to batting order and substitutions. While playing time is NOT GUARANTEED...all players will play throughout the course of the season. Players are put into positions that they can improve in. Coaches will put players into positions that keeps them safe and gives the team the best chance to win.
- 4. It is a commitment.... because of **Position Played**. Practices, skill sets, additional training, experience and game knowledge, ALL have a role in determining the position of each player to help the team. Each player/parent may NOT pick where they play.

Travel baseball is not for every player or every family. However, it can be a truly rewarding experience for the player/family who commits to developing their skill set year-round.

Being on a team means learning responsibility, accountability and asking what they can do to help the team.

Getting to know what you're committing to is the first step in understanding how travel baseball is a commitment to the game.
